

## Clean Highways/Adopt-a-Highway Update

Recently there are several newly adopted areas since our "push" in the media in late 2017:

- Highway 101/1 southbound interchange/ramp - Quezada Architects
- Highway 101 southbound Seminary Drive Park & Ride lot - Clean Mill Valley
- Highway 101/131 northbound and southbound interchange - Rg Environmental Holdings
- Highway 101 northbound and southbound Tamalpais Dr. interchange - Marin Primary & Middle School
- Highway 101 eastbound east of Sir Francis Drake - Rush Injury Law
- Highway 101 westbound Bellam Blvd. - Johnson & Daly Moving & Storage
- Highway 101 northbound and southbound Lucas Valley Road/Smith Ranch Road interchange - Las Gallinas Lions Club
- Highway 101 northbound and southbound St. Vincent Dr./Miller Creek interchange - Las Gallinas Lions Club
- Highway 101 northbound Ignacio Blvd./Bel Marin Keys Blvd. interchange - Chick-fil-a Novato
- Highway 101 southbound Ignacio Blvd./Bel Marin Keys Blvd. interchange - Steve & Joy McKeever

Currently 4 areas available to adopt in Marin (subject to review by Caltrans before approving):

- Highway 101 Park & Ride lot northbound and southbound - Spencer Ave.
- Highway 101/1 Interchange/ramp northbound
- Highway 101 Park & Ride lot Lincoln and Prospect; Irwin and 4th; Heatherton and 5<sup>th</sup>
- Highway 101 Park and Ride lot northbound Rowland Blvd.
- Highway 101 Park and Ride lot northbound and southbound - Atherton Ave.

The vast majority of Marin's highways - 37, 101 and 1 - are not adoptable, due to safety concerns. Clean Highways is currently working with Cal Trans and Hoogasian Florist to clean up the Manzanita Park & ride lot in Mill Valley.
